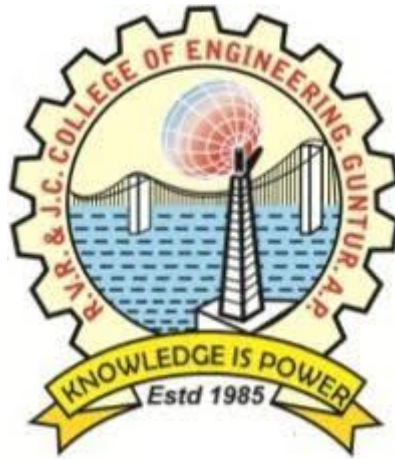

7.1.5.1. The institutional initiatives for greening the campus are as follows:

- **Restricted entry of automobiles**
- **Pedestrian Friendly pathways**
- **Ban on use of Plastic**
- **Landscaping with trees and plants**

RESPONSE:

RVR & JC College of Engineering, one of the best engineering colleges in Andhra Pradesh, has always taken a green agenda. Despite being primarily a technological institution, it has shown remarkable awareness in maintaining an eco-friendly campus. On visiting the Campus, one can experience the aesthetic and elegant buildings, splendid lawns, spacious sports grounds and lush green environment conducive for teaching-learning process.

INSTITUTIONAL INITIATIVES:

RESTRICTED ENTRY OF AUTOMOBILES

The college operates a fleet of 29 buses covering each corner of Guntur to facilitate the students and staff. The institute encourages the staff and students to use the college transport instead of their own vehicles for safety, security, fuel conservation and to reduce environmental pollution. The college buses are checked for pollution by the authorized agency. The vehicles owned by faculty or students with pollution check stickers are permitted into the campus. Random checks are made to check the validation and periodicity of this certificate. For two wheelers or four wheelers, security measures are mandatory.

USE OF BICYCLES

The students staying in boy's hostel are using bicycle to go from hostel to college and vice versa. Students and staff coming from nearby villages also prefer bicycle as a mode of transport for attending the college. It is environment friendly and prevents pollution

PEDESTRIAN FRIENDLY PATHWAYS

Vehicle parking space is provided at the main entrance of the college campus. As the campus is vehicle free with some exceptions, students and staff experience comfort walking through the pedestrian friendly pathways. The internal roads are lined with trees and solar lights and they are properly maintained by the campus maintenance committee.

BAN ON USE OF PLASTIC

Single-use plastic items such as plastic bottles, bags, spoons, straws and cups are banned completely and awareness is created among staff and students through orientation and display boards in the premises. To restrict the use of plastic, measures have been taken to replace plastic tea cups and glasses with steel glasses in the canteen. The staff and students are informed to use steel or copper water bottles instead of plastic bottles.

LANDSCAPING WITH TREES AND PLANTS

Landscaping of the college is worth seeing and reflects aesthetic sense. The institute has a canopy of trees and plants to make the environment pollution free to safeguard the health of all the inmates. The lawns and the trees provide shade and beautiful ambience. Utmost care is taken to develop and maintain green landscaping by trained gardeners and supervisor. The construction, maintenance and beautification committee constituted in the college looks after the development and maintenance of the greenery in the campus.

The institute authorities are taking initiatives to make the campus paperless. Internal communication in the campus, through e-mail or e-messages, is driving towards paperless office. Electronic notice boards are installed in the campus to display circulars and information for the students. Electronic gadgets are preferred to transfer and store the official data and information. Library and examination sections are equipped with efficient software. RVR And JC College Academic Management System (RAJCAMS), the college academic management system and MOODLE, the Learning Management System are used for academic activity in the campus.



NOTICE

All the students are advised to attend the College by College / RTC buses only. If they wish to come by 2-wheeler / 4-wheeler they shall abide by the following instructions:

- 1) Students have to report to the Physical Director along with their parents, submit a declaration form duly signed by the parents and obtain a Valid Vehicle Pass from the Physical Director on or before 11-01-2019.
- 2) Students shall submit copies of Valid Driving License, C-Book and a Passport size photo along with the declaration form.
- 3) They shall possess the Original Driving License, C-Book, Parents' declaration form and College ID with them.
- 4) If they come by 4-wheeler, they shall wear Seat-Belt.
- 5) If they come by 2-wheeler, they shall wear Helmet; triple riding is not permitted.
- 6) They shall park the vehicles in Students Parking Shed only and they are not allowed to park the vehicles at other places.

The Students have to follow the rules 3 to 6 with immediate effect.

The above instructions shall be scrupulously followed by all the students coming to the college by 2-wheeler / 4-wheeler, failing which they will not be allowed to enter the College premises and the vehicles will be seized, with effect from 21-01-2019. Also, they are strictly warned to drive the vehicles at a speed of not more than 60 to 80 km to avoid accidents.

In this context, all the students are hereby informed that the College Main Gate (at Arch) and the Inner Security Gate will be closed by 08.00 a.m., in the 1st shift and by 10.00 a.m., in the 2nd shift. The first shift students will not be permitted to leave the College before 03.00 p.m., and the second shift students will not be permitted to leave the College before 05.00 p.m., **with effect from 21-01-2019**. No student will be allowed outside during the College working hours, even for lunch/snacks. They have to bring their lunch while coming to the college or they can have the lunch in the College Canteen.

The movements of the students are under the surveillance of CC Cameras, covering the Main Entrance Gate and Students Parking Area. A Committee headed by the Physical Director is also formed to monitor the above activity. Any complaint / violation of the above rules will be viewed seriously and disciplinary action will be initiated against the concerned student(s).

All the students are required to cooperate in this regard by following the above instructions carefully.
